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Churches

- Become a "Partner in Mission" by providing regular, annual financial support to Children In Crisis.
 - Be an advocate for children by educating your congregation about abused and neglected children.
 - Invite small groups in your congregation to donate welcome, birthday, and holiday baskets for foster children.
 - Designate one person in the church to oversee and coordinate activities to benefit Children in Crisis.

 - Allow your church youth group to perform an annual fundraiser for Children in Crisis.
